# Hosted by the Scottish Division of the Caravan and Motorhome Club



Grantown-on-Spey 2024

Grantown-on-Spey, in the Scottish Highlands, is perfectly placed by the river Spey in the heart of the Cairngorms National Park. Approximately 20 miles south east of Inverness and at one end of Scotland's 90-mile Snow Road, a stretch of landscape from Blairgowrie in Perth and Kinross shire to Grantown in the Highlands, carved by granite and ice, with breathtaking views.

Known in Gaelic as Baile nan Granndach, the town was founded in 1765 as a planned settlement during the Industrial Revolution and was originally called simply Grantown after Sir James Grant [Chief of Clan Grant]. The addition of 'on Spey' was added by the burgh council in 1898.

The town is surrounded by ancient woodlands, which offer a unique habitat for a wide variety of wildlife. There are also numerous other walks and trails around the town which offer wonderful views over the surrounding hills and mountains. The town's Square and High Street are lined with unique, independent and interesting shops with numerous cafes, bars and restaurants offering a wide range of meals, drinks and snacks to suit all tastes and pockets.

All in all, it is a beautiful, charming town with plenty to do for the day visitor and which offers a unique opportunity to experience a traditional Highland town, dating from 1760s.

#### <u>Strathspey Farmers Club - Heathfield Park [Grantown Showground]</u>

Strathspey Farmers Club has been in existance since 1787 and organises the annual Grantown Show, held in August each year. Heathfield Park is at one end of the town and only a short walk (approx. 15mins) into the town centre and various amenities.

#### **Nearby Attractions**

The town boasts a number of other attractions including a superb 18-hole golf course, the Grantown Heritage Museum, the Cairngorms Activity Centre and of course the Speyside Way walking trail, a 137km route from the mouth of the River Spey on the Moray coast, to the heart of the Cairngorms.

#### Inverness

The Capital of the Highlands lies 35 miles north west of Grantown-on-Spey (by road), with a multitude of tourist attractions, shops and eateries to explore.

#### **Whisky Trail**

Whisky is Scotland's national drink and our biggest export, enjoyed across the globe as well as right here in Scotland. Skilled distillers transform barley and water into a precious spirit, which is tucked away to mature. Grantown-on-Spey is conveniently located near the start of the 70-mile-long famous Speyside Malt Whisky Trail, taking in seven world-famous working distilleries, one historic distillery and the fascinating Speyside Cooperage. Speyside is often called 'Malt Whisky Country' as its home to more than half of Scotland's malt whisky distilleries and is one of the country's five whisky regions.

#### Castles



It is estimated that throughout history Scotland has been home to over 3,000 castles. In the nearby vicinity of Grantown-on-Spey, there are 2 interesting castle ruin sites, Castle Roy and Lochindorb Castle with many more slightly further afield.

Lochindorb comes from the Gaelic meaning 'Loch of Trouble' and the castle has certainly had its fair share of that! Dating back to the 13th century, it was originally held by the Comyns, but later occupied by the English and was visited by Edward I in 1303. Also nearby is Cawdor

Castle, of Macbeth fame, which according to legend, was built around a thorn tree, which can still be seen in the dungeon and has been identified as a holly tree dating from 1372 [approx. 23 miles NW].

#### Further afield

Across the Highlands of Scotland there is an abundance of villages and towns with something to offer, showcasing the various sectors of Scottish culture and scenery.







## THE SCOTTISH CARAVAN CLUB SCOTTISH DIVISION OF THE CARAVAN AND MOTORHOME CLUB

## CONSTITUTION AND RULES October 2017

#### 1. NAME AND STATUS

The Club shall be named THE SCOTTISH CARAVAN CLUB. It is hereinafter called "The Club". It shall be the Scottish Division of the Caravan and Motorhome Club and shall comprise of the Scottish Region of the Caravan and Motorhome Club.

#### 2. OBJECTS

The objects of The Club shall be:

- a) To promote and encourage a high standard of caravanning in Scotland.
- b) To promote and protect the interests of caravanners in Scotland.
- c) To co-operate with the Caravan and Motorhome Club in the establishment, maintenance and development of caravan sites in Scotland.
- To co-ordinate the activities of the Scottish Centres and of Centres visiting Scotland.
- e) To promote the interests of the Caravan and Motorhome Club in Scotland.
- f) To do all such lawful things as may be conducive to the attainment of the above objectives.

#### 3. MEMBERSHIP

- a) Qualification:
  - (i) Ordinary Membership, which shall be of various classes, shall be confined to Members of the Caravan and Motorhome Club residing in Scotland or who are registered with a Centre within The Club.
  - (ii) Honorary Members, appointed by the Council of The Club.
- b) Application for Membership:
  - An application to join the Caravan and Motorhome Club, by any person residing in Scotland or an application by a Caravan and Motorhome Club Member to register with a Centre within The Club shall be deemed to be an application to join The Club.
- c) Subscriptions:
  - (i) The subscriptions and entrance fees shall be those of the Caravan and Motorhome Club, and shall be payable to the Headquarters of the Caravan and Motorhome Club.
  - (ii) The payment of a subscription to the Caravan and Motorhome Club shall have the effect as the payment of a subscription to The Club and, in respect thereof, the Caravan and Motorhome Club will arrange payment to The Club of such grants as may be determined from time to time.
  - (iii) The Club shall not impose any additional subscription on Members but may collect fees from Members and visitors for events organised by it.
  - (iv) The Club or any Member shall not pledge the credit of the Caravan

and Motorhome Club unless authorised by the Caravan and Motorhome Club.

d) Discipline:

The Council shall consider any breach of the Caravan and Motorhome Club Rules by a Member and if thought necessary, shall report the circumstances to the Caravan and Motorhome Club who may take disciplinary action.

#### 4. COUNCIL

- a) The Council shall consist of:
  - (i) President, Vice-Presidents, Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Hon. Secretary, Hon. Treasurer and Equipment Officer, Hon. Editor and Rally Secretary, Hon. P.R.O. They shall be elected each year, subject to proviso of 4(b), at the Annual General Meeting and shall form the Elected Officers.
  - (ii) Two delegates appointed by the Committee of each Centre within The Club.
  - (iii) Up to three Non-Centre Members, co-opted with the approval of the Executive Committee.
  - (iv) Any member of the Council of the Caravan and Motorhome Club residing in Scotland, not being an Elected Officer of The Club, or a Centre Representative to the Council of The Club, may be in attendance with the right to speak, but not to vote.
  - (v) Any member of the Sites Committee of the Caravan and Motorhome Club residing in Scotland may be in attendance with the right to speak, but not to vote.
- b) Vice-Presidents shall not exceed three in number, one of whom shall be the immediate past Chairman for one year, if available.
- c) The President, Vice-Presidents, Chairman and Vice-Chairman may normally serve a maximum of two consecutive years and other Elected Officer may normally serve a maximum of five consecutive years. However, the nomination of any such member for any further period in Office may be accepted with the agreement of the Council and the Member may subsequently serve in Office if elected.
- d) No Elected Officer of Council may hold Office in any form within a Centre.
- e) The following shall be ex-officio members of the Council: The Chairman, Vice-Chairman and the Director General of the Caravan and Motorhome Club.
- f) Should a vacancy occur in the Elected Officers on the Council during the year, the Council may appoint a Member to fill the vacancy.
- g) At Council meetings, eight shall form a quorum.
- h) The Officers of the Council, namely, the President, Vice-Presidents, Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Hon. Secretary, Hon. Treasurer and Equipment Officer, Hon. Editor and Rally Secretary and Hon. P.R.O. shall be ex-officio members of all Centre Committees within The Club.
- i) The activities of The Club shall be controlled by the Council, who shall have the following powers:
  - (i) To appoint committees with the powers to co-opt Members.
  - (ii) To recommend to the Caravan and Motorhome Club the formation of local Centres.

- (iii) To appoint Honorary Members.
- (iv) To organise caravan rallies and other social events.
- (v) To assist in the promotion of the Caravan and Motorhome Club interests in Scotland.

#### MEETINGS

- a) The Annual General Meeting of The Club shall be held at a time and place fixed at The Club's Annual General Meeting of by the Council. At the meeting, the Hon. Secretary shall present his/her report and the Hon. Treasurer and Equipment Officer shall submit a Statement of Accounts and Balance Sheet duly audited for the preceding financial year. Nominations for Elected Officers signed by the nominee must be received in writing by the Hon. Secretary of The Club not less than 28 days prior to the Annual General Meeting. The Hon. Secretary shall make every reasonable effort to give notice of valid nominations for Elected Officers to Members prior to the Annual General Meeting or a statement that a list of the nominations is available from the Hon. Secretary on request.
- b) Notice of the Annual General Meeting, specifying the date, time, place and main objects of the meeting shall be given in a circular sent to each Full Member, or in the book of events published by the Council, or in the Caravan and Motorhome Club Magazine, but the non-receipt of such a Notice shall not invalidate the proceeding at any meeting. Notice to Joint and Family Members shall be deemed to have been fully and properly given if sent to the Full Member.
- c) Notices of Special Motion for the Annual General Meeting must be lodged with the Hon. Secretary not less than three calendar months prior to the Meeting. The Hon. Secretary shall make every reasonable effort to give notice of a Special Motion to Members prior to the Annual General Meeting by circulating either the Special Motion or a statement that copies of the Special Motion will be available from the Hon. Secretary on request.
- d) A Special General Meeting of The Club shall be called by the Hon. Secretary on receipt of either:
  - (i) Instructions from the Council **OR**
  - (ii) A request in writing, giving 90 days' notice, signed by not fewer than twenty-five Full Members, such request setting out clearly the purpose for which a Special General Meeting is desired, providing not less than fourteen clear days' notice be given to Members.

The notice calling a Special General Meeting shall set forth clearly the purpose for which the Meeting is being held or shall otherwise make known that a clear statement of that purpose will be available from the

- e) Hon. Secretary on request.
- At all General Meetings, twenty-five Members with voting powers shall f) form a quorum.
  - At the General Meetings, the Chairman of The Club shall preside, failing him/her, the Vice Chairman and, in the absence of both, the meeting shall elect a Chairman.

#### 6 VOTING POWERS

At the General Meetings, each Full, Joint and Family Member shall, on the production of a current Caravan and Motorhome Club Membership Card, have one vote. When more than one nomination is received, voting shall be by secret ballot.

#### 7 FINANCE

- a) The financial year of The Club shall end on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December.
- b) Prior to the Annual General Meeting and at such other times as the Council may think fit the books and accounts of the Hon. Treasurer and Equipment Officer shall be audited by the Auditor.
- c) The Auditor, properly qualified, not a member of the Council, shall be appointed annually at the Annual General Meeting. The Auditor's expenses will be defrayed by the Caravan and Motorhome Club.
- No Member may pledge the Credit of The Club unless authorised by the Council.
- e) The Scottish Caravan Club Handbook of Events shall be produced by The Club.

### 8 REPRESENTATION ON CLUB COUNCIL and DIVISIONAL & REGIONAL FORUM

The Club will send representatives to the Caravan and Motorhome Club Council and the Divisional & Regional Forum, with the total number to be determined for any one year by the Executive Committee of the Caravan and Motorhome Club. The representatives shall be appointed by the Council annually, but the Caravan and Motorhome Club Council representative must be selected from one of the appointed Divisional & Regional Form representatives.

#### 9 CLUB SITES

- a) Caravan and Motorhome Club sites in Scotland are the property of the Caravan and Motorhome Club and will be administered by the Sites Committee under the Caravan and Motorhome Club Site Rules.
- b) The Club shall co-operate with the Caravan and Motorhome Club in the development and maintenance of Caravan and Motorhome Club Sites by nominating Site Inspectors at the request of the Caravan and Motorhome Club.

#### 10 LOCAL CENTRES

Centres formed under Paragraph 4(i) (ii) shall operate under the Rules Governing Centres as laid down by the Caravan and Motorhome Club.

#### 11 ALTERATION OF CONSTITUTION

Additions or amendments to the Constitution shall be made only at a General Meeting of The Club by the vote of two-thirds of the Members present and voting at such a Meeting shall be subject to the approval of the Caravan and Motorhome Club. Not less than three calendar months' notice of motion to make such additions or amendments shall be given in writing to the Hon. Secretary. The motion shall be made known to the Members by circulating either the motion or a statement indicating that copies of the motion will be available from the Hon. Secretary on request.


